Budget and Finance Report

The Budget and Finance Committee had a meeting last month. Discussion from that meeting included- The world convention is coming up. The State Association normally covers the cost of sending its board members. Which includes registration as well as hotel fees. That cost has been roughly \$15,000-\$20,000. There hasn't been a line item in the past for the world convention in the budget. Because this expense has come out of the reserve funds in our account. This year we did budget \$9,000 for the World Convention. So that should alleviate some of the cost coming directly out of our reserve.

Now I will go through each line item in the budget.

State Meetings: \$3,297.18 total has been spent out of \$11,500 in the budget.

Line items in this category include:

Hosting Donations-\$200 spent of the \$600 budgeted.

Food Expenses- \$965.17 spent out of the \$3,000 budgeted.

Travel Expenses- \$1,732.01 spent of the \$6,700 budgeted.

Transfer to Savings-\$400 transferred to savings of the \$1,200 budgeted for.

IT: \$1,100 total has been spent out of \$2,700 budgeted for in this category.

Chapter Donations (Emergency Situations): We have spent \$0 of \$11,000 allocated for this category.

Alumni: \$3,500 has been spent of the \$7,800 allocated for this category.

Which included \$3500 was spent for the alumni luncheon at world.

Officer Trainings- \$0 of the \$3,800 allocated for.

Unity Events- \$1,800 of the \$4,000 allocated for.

\$1000 for a golf tournament in Wichita. And \$800 for The Softball tournament in Wichita.

Re-Entry Report

For March we accepted 36 out of 72 applicants with a 50% rate and for April we accepted 31 out of 58 applicants with a 53% rate for a total of 67 out of 130 with a combined percentage of 52%. Our current balance in checking is \$2394.26 and we have \$1759.65 in savings. We have funded a total of 81 re entries for a total of \$12,650.00. We have bracelets for \$2 each for our fundraiser. We currently have 114 houses that support reentry.

April 21st through the 26th we held our World Council Summit in Arkansas. Bringing other members of the Oxford House World Council from across the country together to offer suggestions, discover solutions and brainstorming ideas to help in continuing the important work we are all involved in.

Many of you saw the new World Council Resolution Handout with the resolutions found in the World Council Manual updated and gone through for relevance and cleaning up the ones that have been superceded by updated resolutions. We also cleaned up the committees of the World Council all of you are invited to partake in. Those of you that attended the town hall style meeting on zoom and actually joined us at the Summit are aware of these changes. But for those of you that weren't able to join us we got rid of the standards, development, convention, and propagation committees. We then proceeded to combine the chapters and associations Committees into one, we kept the charter and alumni committee, then added engagement, networking, and the technology and environmental committees. I'm honored to serve along with such an amazing team of dedicated people. Currently there are 3,812 Oxford Houses worldwide providing 31,545 beds for people seeking options to begin or continue their path of recovery which was updated at our most recent OHI Board of directors meeting held on Friday April 26th.

We plan on continuing to do our part as representatives of Kansas on the Oxford House World Council traveling to MULTIPLE state conventions and workshops. Kansas is always there showing the rest of the network what we do and how we do it. I am honored to serve Kansas, the council and our communities. We have some exciting things in the works! F.O.R.A. Report

Reminder, monthly house reports are due at the end of the month. This is important for FORA to get these statistics; it helps us help you!

Medications in houses are extremely important. Each household should ensure that every Members who require narcotics or MAR medication has their own lock box to store it. The key to the lock box should be held solely by the individual for whom the medication is prescribed. During medication checks, two other household members should be present along with the prescribed individual. Only the prescribed individual should handle their own medication. It is recommended to conduct random medication checks a few times a week or even more frequently, and to vary the days on which these checks occur.

Every year Oxford House, Inc. conducts an evaluation of key states that contain multiple Oxford Houses. This year Kansas has been selected! Please have each house members follow the link and complete the survey. The information is 100% confidential and anonymous. Filling out the questions takes less than 5 minutes and can be done by everyone at your next house meeting. The survey is completed online by following the link and simply choose your house at the beginning and answer the questions. You do not need to be logged into your house email account to complete; the survey can be done from your computer or personal cell phone. The survey must be completed by all residents as soon as possible. But do NOT share through Facebook messenger! This survey is important for several reasons: (1) It helps Oxford House, Inc. and Friends of Recovery Association (FORA) understand how to serve your area better, (2) It shows the local government how successful we are in changing lives, and (3) It shows the public that recovery works. The data collected is compiled and analyzed to provide state-wide statistics that prove our success regardless of any differences we have as members before finding recovery. Oxford House, Inc. and FORA will take this 'snap shot' of membership and turn it into a multi-page evaluation that can be distributed to the public. Your Participation in this project is very important. It can help us open more houses in the future so people seeking recovery in a safe, supportive, and structured living environment can have the same opportunity to move into Oxford House that you had when you were ready.

FORA is actively pursuing conditional charters for over 30 houses with OHI. Once all necessary paperwork is completed, FORA or your nearest outreach coordinator will contact the houses to facilitate the submission of permanent charter paperwork to OHI. Kansas has historically faced challenges in providing documentation to OHI and updating their database. This situation is now undergoing significant improvement! FORA is excited to announce we will be opening a resource center very soon. Although this is going to be based in Overland Park it will indeed benefit the entire state and will and everyone across the state will get to utilize it. More coming soon!

Today I want to talk about Chapters' presence in a house and what is expected, along with what is not expected from chapter. When there is a problem in a house and chapter is called into help, the chapter is there to provide suggestions and examples to give the house the information to base their decision. What the house decides to do is their decision. As long as a house isn't breaking the charter, chapter has no authority over a house's decisions.

On that note it is not chapter responsibility to govern your house...examples if your house isn't voting the way someone likes or agrees with it is not chapter responsibility to do something about it. All you can do is offer advice and suggestions. Give the house examples of what could or has happened given the situation. Chapter is there to support a house help them figure out issues but never to make decisions for a house.

Chapter should never DBOE, govern, police, (for lack of a better term) a house into voting a certain way. This takes away the purpose of being ran democratically. This also creates a fear of chapter. We never want members to fear chapter...we want to build a strong relationship based on trust. I honestly believe we could prevent a lot of restructures this way. I believe we can prevent restructures by building a strong bond between chapter and our house members by eliminating the fear of chapter and making sure members feel comfortable seeking advice from chapter without fear of reprisal.


