Motioned to accept the meeting minutes from November accepted as published on the website: MSP

First off, I would like to welcome all of our new leadership from across the state. My name is Buster Pulley. This report includes our spending vs. what was budgeted for 2024.

First category up, State Meetings: \$10,732.25 total has been spent out of \$11,500 in the budget. Line items in this category include: Hosting Donations-\$500 spent of the \$600 budgeted for. Which includes \$100 spent last meeting.

Food Expenses- \$1,965.17 spent out of the \$3,000 budgeted.

Travel Expenses- \$7,067.08 spent of the \$6,700 budgeted for. Which includes \$648 in reimbursements last meeting.

Transfer to Savings-\$1,200 transferred to savings of the \$1,200 budgeted for. Which includes \$200 transferred from checking to savings at the last meeting.

IT: \$3,039 total has been spent out of \$2,700 budgeted for in this category. \$739 was paid out for IT last meeting. Which included \$400 for IT and \$339 for Word Press for 2 years. We ended up over budget in this category because 2023 \$300 for Word Press was turned in at the January 2024 meeting. Which is fine because our budget for 2025 won't have this fee to account for.

Chapter Donations (Emergency Situations): We have spent \$11,000 of \$11,000 allocated for this category.

Alumni: \$7,300 has been spent of the \$7,800 allocated for this category.

World Council: \$14,000 has been spent of \$14,000 budgeted for in this category.

4TK: We have spent \$14,000 of \$14,000 allocated for. This \$14,000 was paid out to each area last meeting.

Conventions: \$59,000 spent of \$59,000 in this category. Which includes- State Convention- We have spent \$50,000 of the \$50,000 allocated for.

World Convention- We have spent \$9,000 of \$9,000 allocated for.

Out of State Donations: \$5,000 has been spent of \$5,000 budgeted for.

The 2 Line items in this category include- Emergency Situations-We have spent \$2,500 of \$2,500 allocated for. Natural Disasters- We have spent \$2,500 of \$2,500 allocated for.

We spent \$124,071.25 of the \$125,000 in categories budgeted for the year. However, we also had some expenses that were pulled from the reserve funds that took our spending over what we actually brought in for the year. Those expenses totaled \$18,900. So essentially, we went \$18,000 over budget for the year. We did take in some fines that were paid and bed dues were raised in September which off set the actual amount we went over slightly.

The Budget and Finance committee will be meeting to finalize this year's budget proposal next month. As mandated in our by-laws, we will be presenting this year's budget proposal at our next State meeting in March.

That concludes my report.

The statistical data regarding webpage views and visitors continues to show significant increases during this reporting period of November & December of 2024. The website received 8,295 views, which is up 1,231 views from the two months previous. When compared to this same reporting period in 2023, our views more than doubled and were up by 4,479 views. Comparing year over year, in 2023 we had 23,381 views, however in 2024 we had 38,343 views, which is 14,962 views over 2023. Our website traffic continues to be increasing, indicating that our website continues to be a resource.

We accepted 22/53 applications for November for a 42% rate and accepted 28/70 for December for a 40% acceptance rate, for a total of 50/123 for a combined acceptance rate of 41%. Our checking account balance is \$4681.30 and our Savings balance is \$10.34. We have funded a total of 141 reentry for a total of \$21,025.00. Carl is very busy in Florida attending meetings from recent splits to see how they do things. We had hoped for participation from around the country to get ideas of what the membership of Oxford would like to see this committee focus on. Attempts to get the word out through Facebook pages has not produced the attendance we hoped. At the recent World Council business meeting it was suggested that one of our projects could be to make a database that includes every state chair. We restructured two houses in October. Both are full and unity is improving, but accountability is lacking.

One of the houses misunderstood the EES rules and is dangerously close to violating charter, with seven

of eight members carrying a negative EES balance for multiple consecutive weeks. We are replicating fiercely.

We were proud to contribute to the Wichita area raising and paying out a total of \$13,040 to the 4TK program.

We held elections last week and Antoine Alexander is our new Chapter Chair.
